## Early Resident of Tenth Ward Dies At Kaysville Home

Mrs. Mary I. Newton Strong, 84, wife of the late Hyrum Strong, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Myrtle Gailey, in Kaysville at 12:20 a.m. Tuesday, after a prolonged illness.



Mrs. Strong was born in Manchester, England, April 8, 1849. She came to Utah with her parents, Joseph L. and Elizabeth Newton when she was about four years of age and like other immigrants of that day walked most of the distance from Council Bluffs, Ia. They settled in the Tenth ward, in Salt Lake City, where Mrs. Strong resided until May 30, 1894 when the family moved to Kaysville. She has been an active worker in the Church.

She is survived by the following children; Irvin J. and Ralph J. Strong of Salt Lake, Mrs. Myrtle Gailey, Kaysville; Mrs. Mae Simons, Layton; and Mrs. Daisy Norman, Blackfoot, Ida., and three great grandchildren. Funeral arrangements were not completed Tuesday.
